

## CANDLERIDGE PLAZA SENIOR HOUSING COMMUNITY

**PROGRAM OVERVIEW** Located in the Knoxville suburb of Powell, Tennessee, Volunteers of America's Candleridge Plaza Senior Housing Community provides 100 quality, affordable housing units to low income individuals who are 62 years of age or older or disabled. The Candleridge Plaza Service Coordination Program helps residents maintain their independence by networking residents with community resources such as transportation, housekeeping assistance, meal delivery and legal advocacy.

Additional services include helping residents access benefits, providing wellness and preventative health care opportunities, monitoring services, and promoting continued self-sufficiency. All services are free and confidential. The program is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

**PROJECT OUTCOMES** 88% of residents were formally assessed in independent living

- 96% of respondents surveyed indicated they benefited from the services
- 98% of respondents surveyed indicated they were satisfied with the services
