

HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS

PROGRAM OVERVIEW Volunteers of America's HOPWA (Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS) program provides emergency financial assistance to individuals with HIV/AIDS who are at risk of becoming homeless or losing their utility services. In addition to housing and utilities assistance, HOPWA also provides a variety of resources to clients to help them achieve long-term housing stability.

Resources provided to clients include PNC Bank financial management classes, legal assistance, career opportunities and nutritional supplement options.

- 100% of all clients who received services from HOPWA maintained stable housing for at least one year
