PROGRAM OVERVIEW Volunteers of America's Woodgreen Apartments provide 20 quality, affordable housing units to low-income persons with severe mental illness. The Woodgreen Service Coordination Program helps residents maintain their independence by networking residents with community resources such as transportation, housekeeping assistance, meal delivery and legal advocacy. Additional services include helping residents access benefits, providing wellness and preventative health care opportunities, monitoring services and promoting continued self-sufficiency. All services are free and confidential. The program is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
