

What does RJ do?

Restorative Justice (RJ) offers creative, alternative solutions for youth who come in contact with the criminal justice system and provides healing and restoration for victims of crime.

Restorative Justice Works

Serving Victims

The RJ process allows victims of crime to participate more fully in the resolution of the offense - with a focus on seeking solutions and making amends.

Investing in Youth

RJ supports positive behavioral changes and re-integration into the community.

Cost Savings

The cost for every youth who enters the RJ process is one-third the amount for a youth in the traditional criminal justice system.

Safer Communities

RJ cuts the recidivism rate by half for every youth who participates. RJ has an impressive record in Kentucky that demonstrates that young people served are far less likely to commit a future offense.

What You Can Do

Volunteer to be a RJ facilitator. We are also looking for individuals to be 'community representatives.' This volunteer opportunity engages participants to speak to the impact of the crime in their community.
